Subject: Diabetic Supplies

We are pleased to announce that effective August 1, 2010 will be the preferred provider for **all** diabetic supplies.

You will no longer be required to purchase your diabetic supplies from a Blue Cross participating durable medical equipment provider. You will now purchase your diabetic supplies from your local participating RxEdo Prescription Drug Program pharmacy. The same pharmacy where you purchase your medications!

Just present your RxEdo Prescription Drug program card at participating pharmacies with a diabetic supply prescription from your doctor. You will be able to purchase a 30 day supply at the applicable co-pays. The plan deductible no longer applies for diabetic supplies. Covered supplies include: insulin syringes, insulin needles, pen needles, lancets and glucometers.

Please do not give your pharmacist your Blue Cross card. Diabetic supplies are not covered under the Blue Cross program, effective August 1, 2010. Make sure you present your RxEdo Pharmacy Program identification card and purchase your supplies at a participating pharmacy only. Participating pharmacies include, but are not limited to, CVS, Walgreens, Publix, Winn-Dixie, Wal-Mart, etc. Please note that you will not be able to order your diabetic supplies through the Walgreens Mail Order program. However, you can purchase the supplies at your local Walgreens Pharmacy.

Here you can locate pharmacies, view maps, driving directions, and there is also a closest proximity search. Information on drugs and health conditions can also be found on the website. To create your RxEdo website online account, you will need to enter your name, member ID, and Rx PCN as it appears on your RxEdo identification card.
