

# THEME PARK / FIELD TRIP SAFETY TIPS

- Know that you are a gift from God and it is important for you to stay safe while having fun during your visit to a theme park or on a field trip.
- Keep cell phone numbers for your parents, guardians, and other trusted adults with you at all times. Call a trusted adult if at any time, you feel uncomfortable with where you are or the people you are with.
- You can actually have more fun without the use of drugs or alcohol. Be careful who gives you drinks and who holds your drinks for you.
- How you dress is a reflection of who you are. Dress modestly to show that you have respect for the person God created you to be.
- Posting and sending pictures of yourself or others is permanent. Don't take pictures of anyone if they are dressed inappropriately. Be aware that others can take pictures of anything you are doing and post them anywhere. There can be permanent consequences for these actions.
- You have a promising future—don't compromise it with actions or words during your visit to a theme park or while on a field trip.
- Go to a park attendant if you at any time feel frightened or threatened.
- Let us pray for each other and for all who will be out enjoying themselves in order that we will have a happy and safe time at the park or on a field trip.
