

Effective immediately, Diocesan travel and return to work/school protocols are updated as follows. These changes apply to all Diocesan employees and Students enrolled in Diocesan/Parish Schools.

For international travel since a negative test is required before boarding as well as masking during flight, we are no longer requiring a mandatory quarantine upon returning to the US. Persons demonstrating ANY symptoms which might be Covid related MUST quarantine until there are no symptoms for 10 calendar days or a negative PCR test is obtained.

For domestic travel, there will not be a quarantine period upon return home. Again, persons demonstrating ANY symptoms which might be Covid related MUST quarantine until there are no symptoms for 10 calendar days or a negative PCR test is obtained.

Masking is still encouraged, and pastors may impose local masking policies in churches and parish facilities.

If ANY potential covid symptoms develop at any stage, individuals should quarantine and/or test according to prescribed protocols. All other Diocesan protocols regarding exposure to others who may be positive for Covid-19 remain in effect. Diocesan policies are independent of public guidelines given our unique circumstances with churches and schools and should not be considered amended unless/until notified by the Diocese.
