

Sextortion is a type of blackmail used by offenders to acquire additional sexual content from you and coerce you into engaging in sexual activity or try to obtain money from you.



It's scary when this happens to you, but it can happen to anyone.

You can remain anonymous while using the service and you won't have to send your images or videos to anyone.

Who Are the Perpetrators?

Often, victims know their extorters. They are current or former romantic partners. They may hold an initial sexual image that was sent intentionally by the victim and are now using it to get more content; threatening to spread the picture to friends and family if the victim does not comply.

What you can do?

Remember, there are bad people out there. It is not your fault. It is never too late to ask a trusted adult for help. We are here to help YOU.

Take it Down

This service is one step you can take to help remove online nude, partially nude, or sexually explicit photos and videos taken before you were 18.
